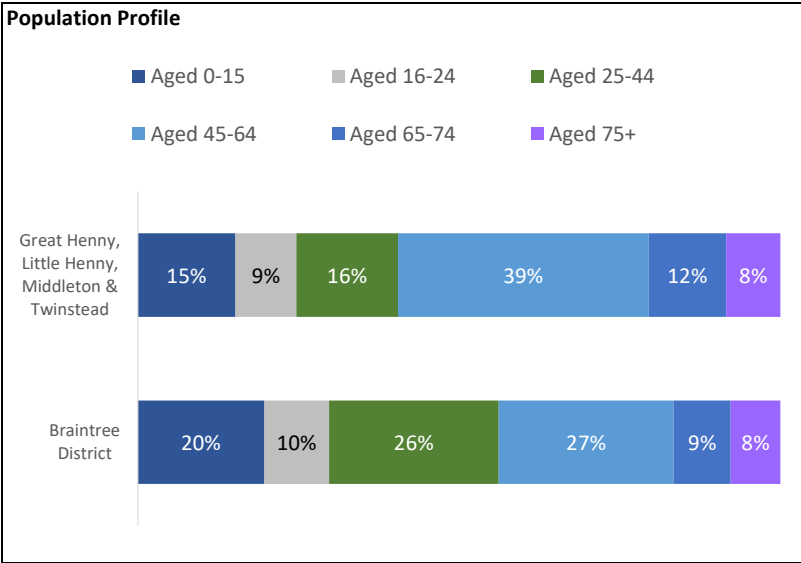

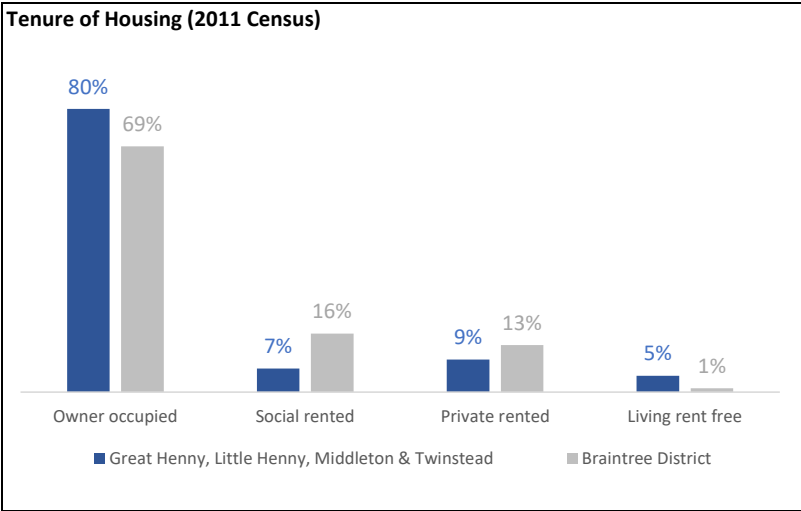


**Key Parish Statistics**

- Population (2011 Census) - 474
- Households (2011 Census) - 197
- The population is 0.3% of the total Braintree District population (147,084)

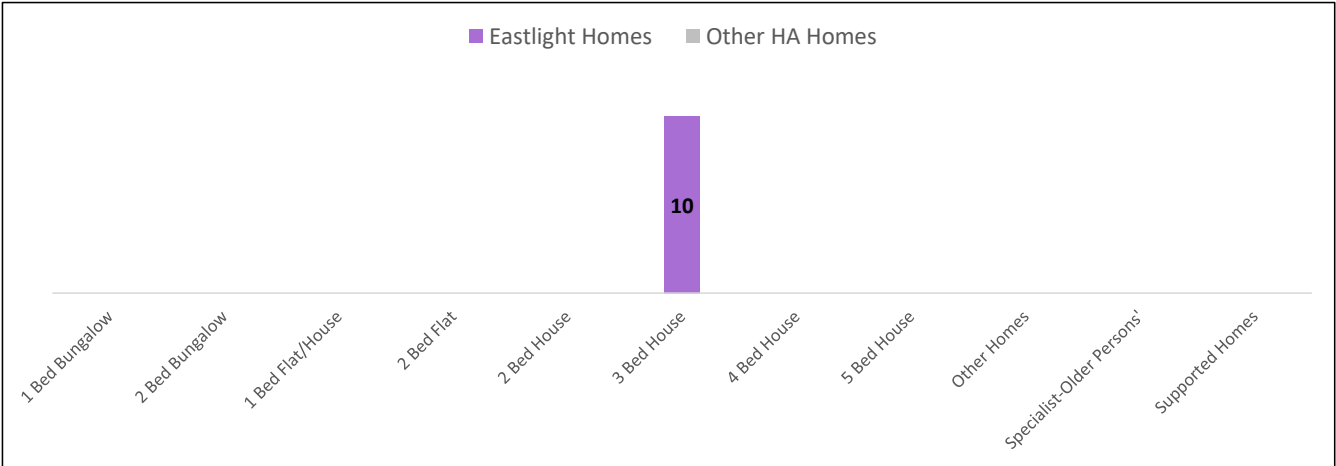
**Over a quarter are couple households (under the age of 65) with no children**  
At 28% of households, this is higher than the Braintree District proportion of 20%

**Lower proportion of single person households under the age of 65**  
Just 9% of households are single people under the age of 65, which is lower than the 15% for Braintree District or the 16% for the East of England

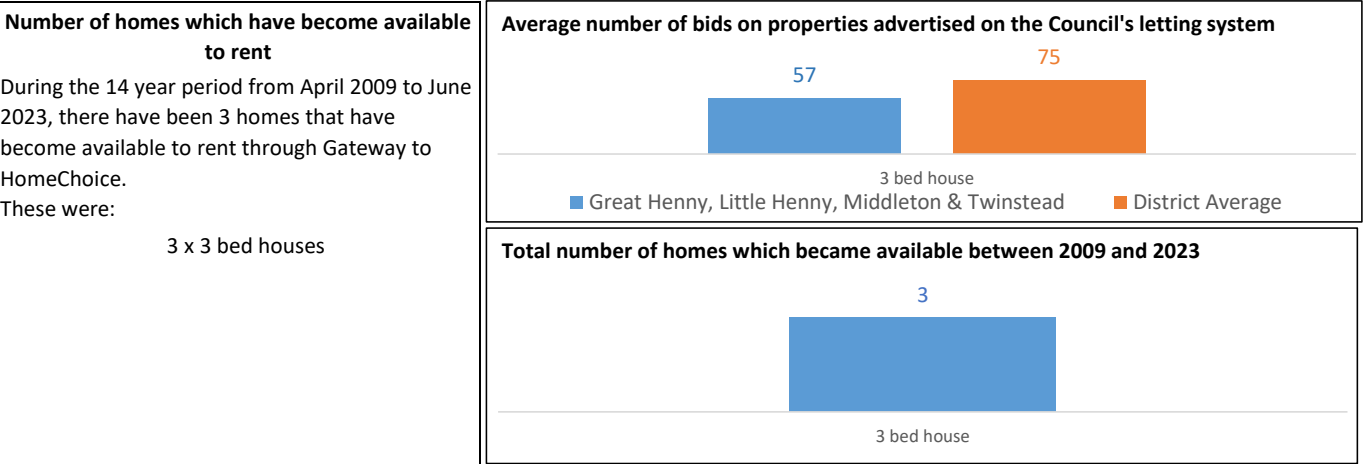


## Housing Association homes to rent in Great Henny, Little Henny, Middleton & Twinstead

Applicants waiting for a housing association home to rent

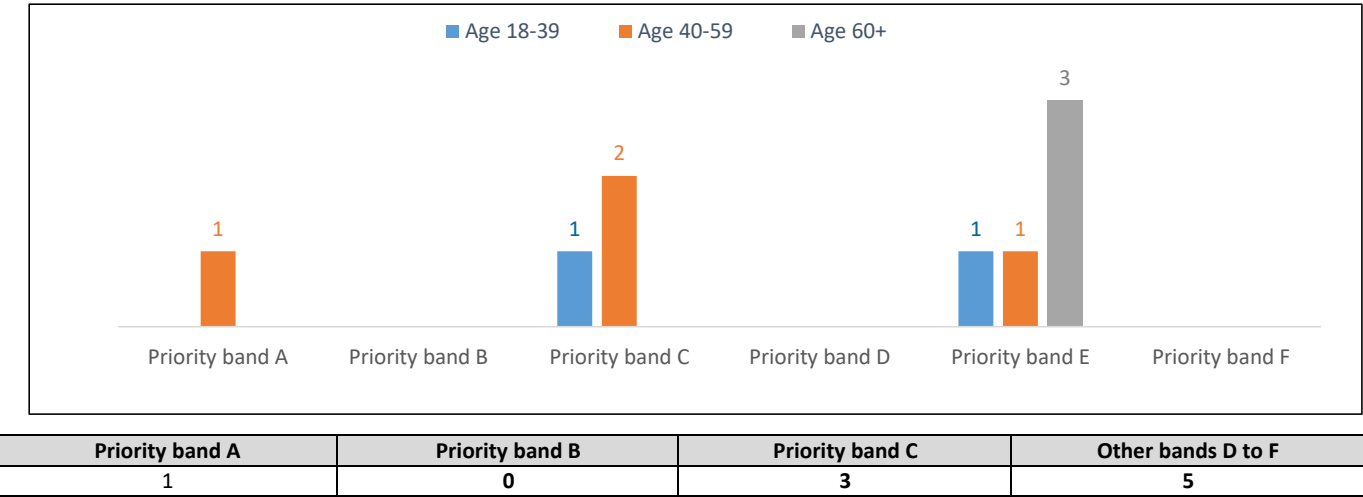
