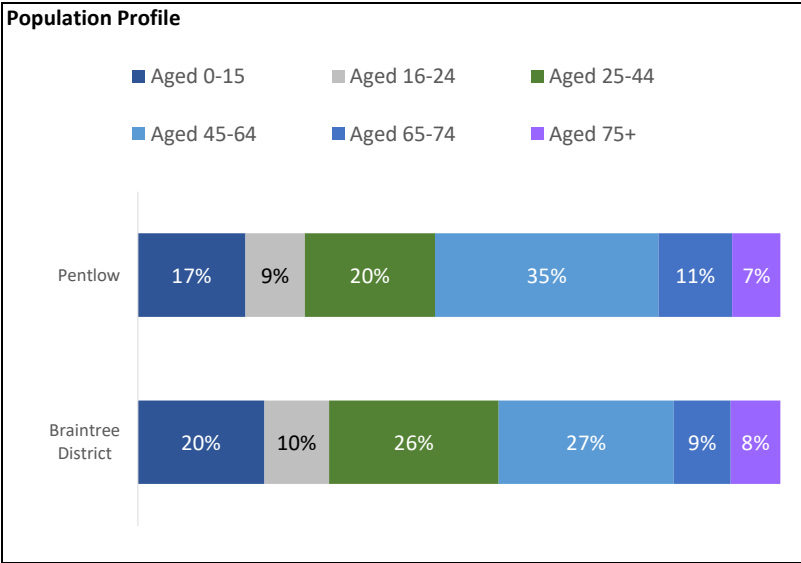

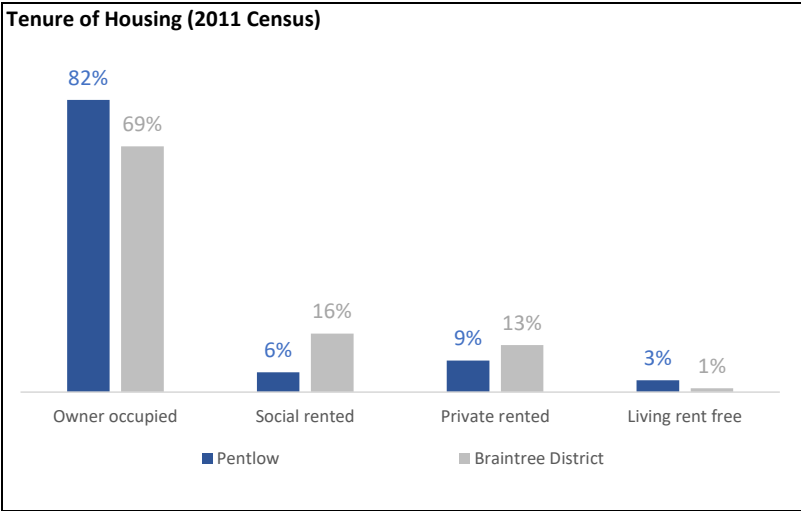


Key Parish Statistics

- The population is 0.2% of the total Braintree District population (147,084)

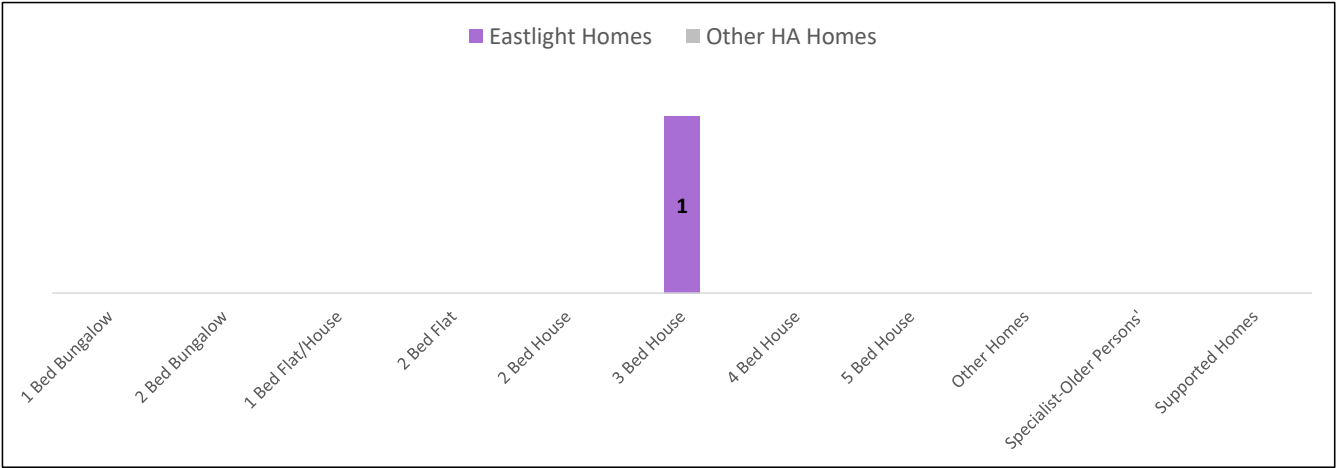
Higher proportion of couples with no children (under 65)
28% of households in the parish are couple households with no children, compared to the District and East of England averages of 20% and 19%

There were 1 Housing Association homes to rent in Pentlow as at July 2023.



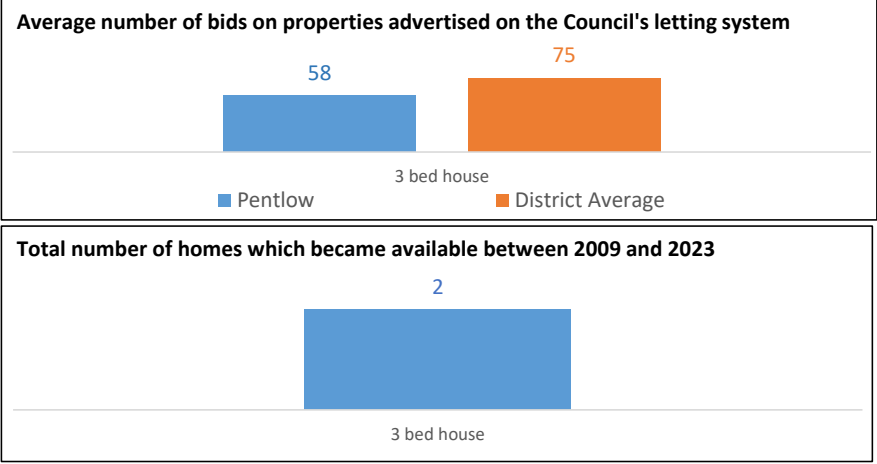
