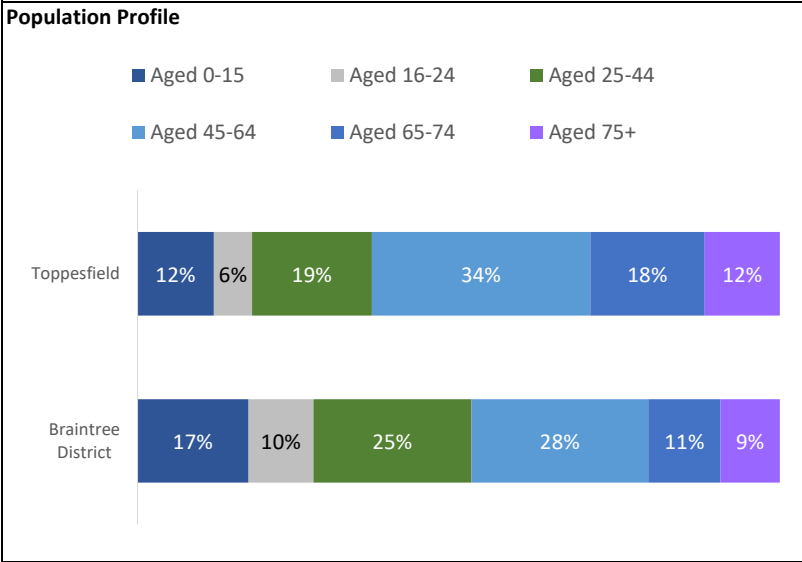

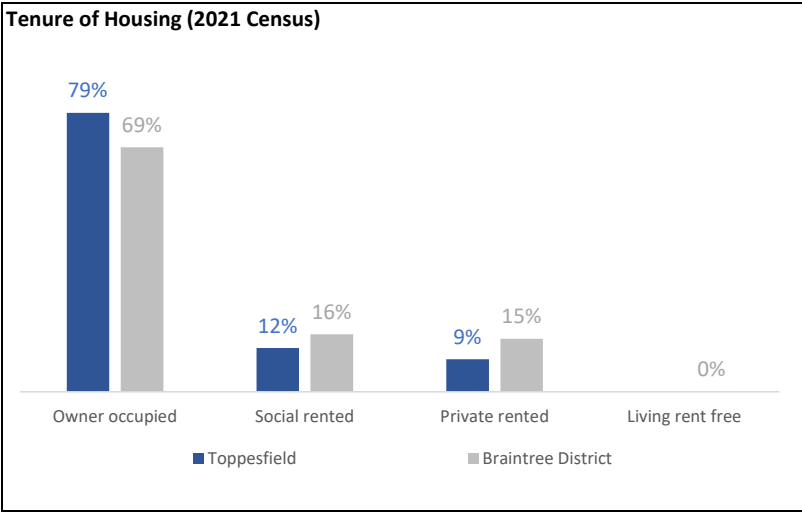
Key Parish Statistics

- Population (2021 Census) - 488

- The population is 0.3% of the total Braintree District population (155,233)

40.8% of households in Toppesfield are economically inactive, which is higher than the 36.9% across the district.

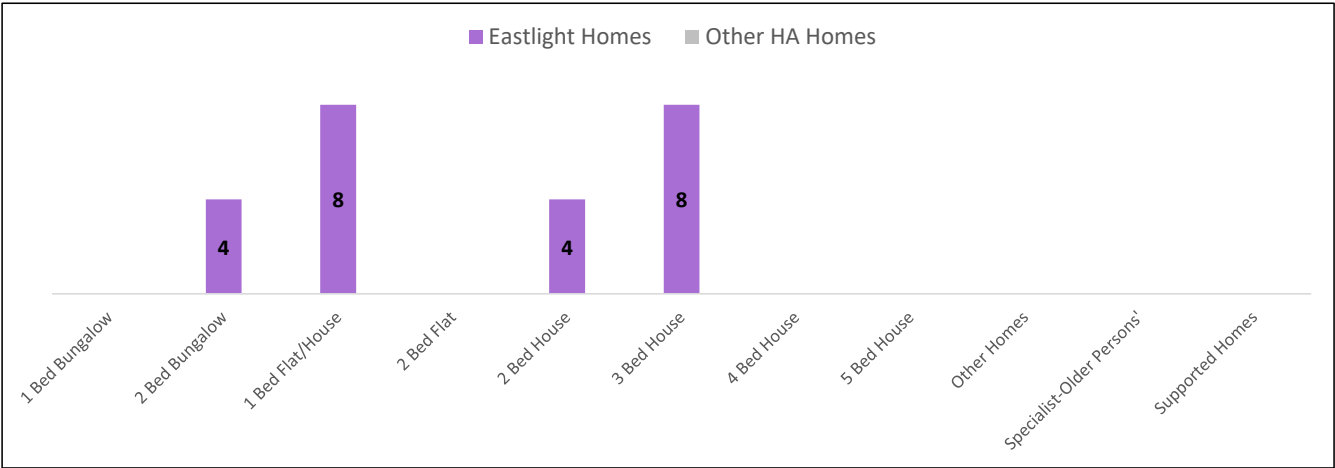
29.2% of households in Toppesfield are couples without children, which is higher than the 18.6% across the district.

20.3% of households in Toppesfield are couples with children, which is lower than the 28.3% across the district.

There were 24 Housing Association homes to rent in Toppesfield as at October 2024.



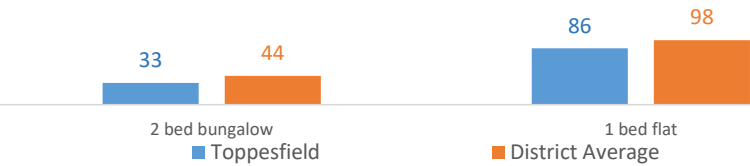
Lettings history in Toppesfield

Number of homes which have become available to rent

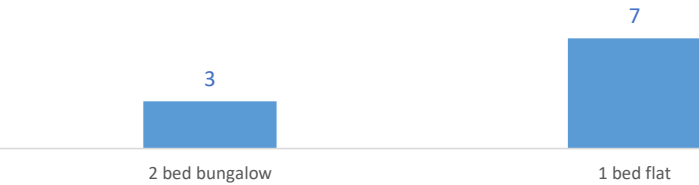
During the 15 year period from April 2009 to October 2024, there have been 10 homes that have become available to rent through Gateway to HomeChoice.

Applicants waiting for a housing association home to rent

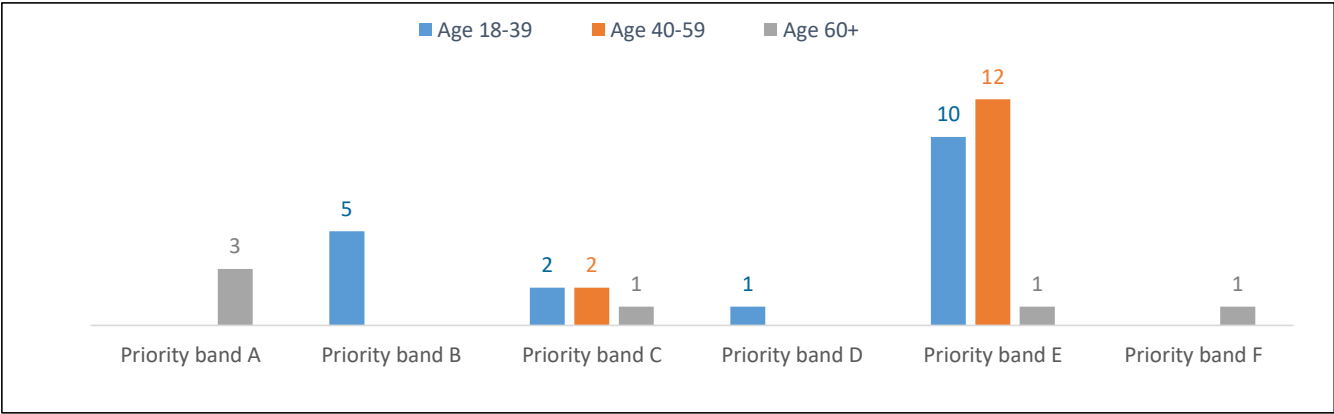
