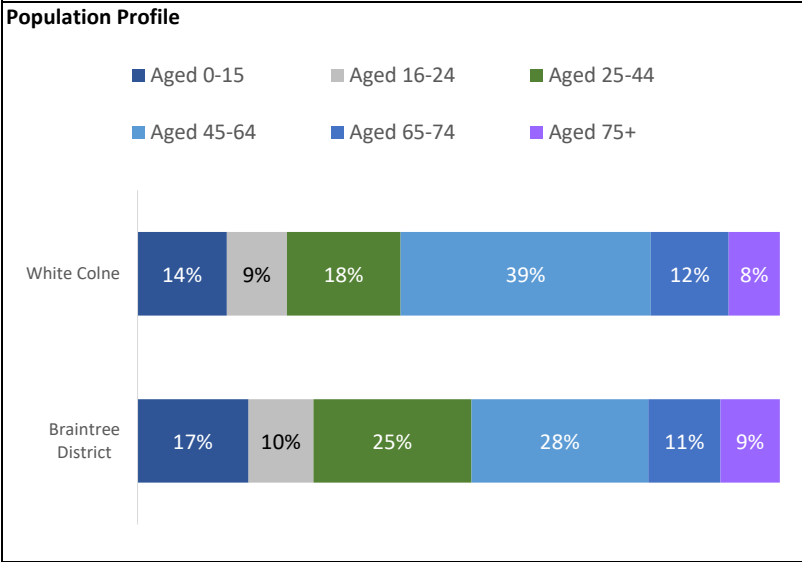

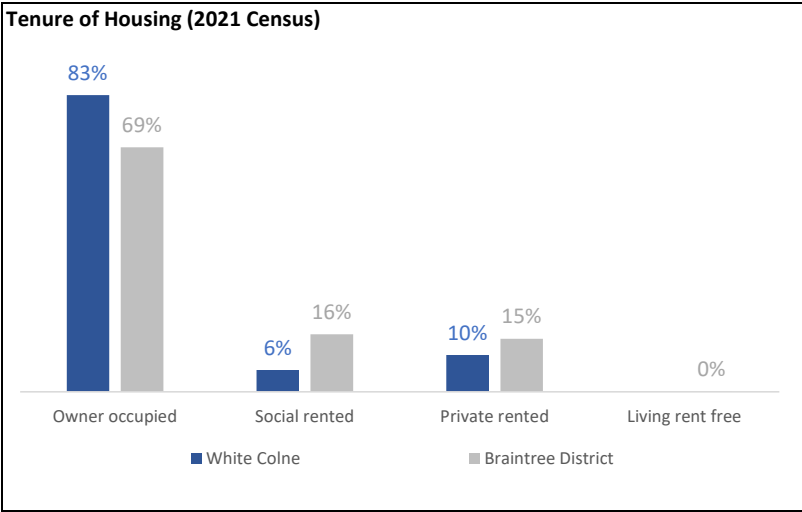
Key Parish Statistics

65.4% of households in White Colne are economically active excluding students, which is higher than the 61.1% across the district.

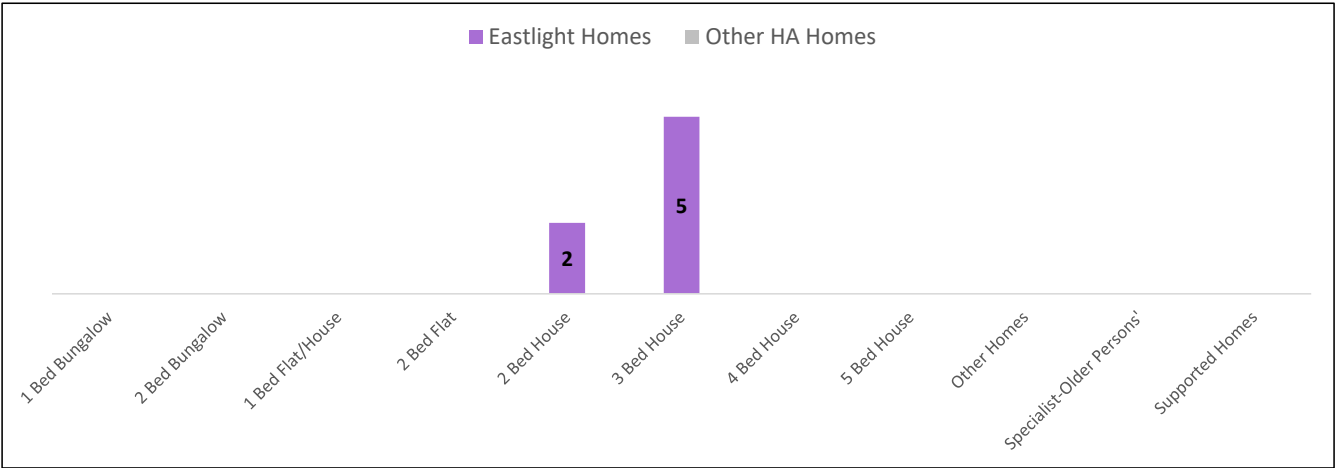
16.9% of households in White Colne are one person households over 65yrs, which is higher than the 13.2% across the district.

There were 7 Housing Association homes to rent in White Colne as at October 2024.



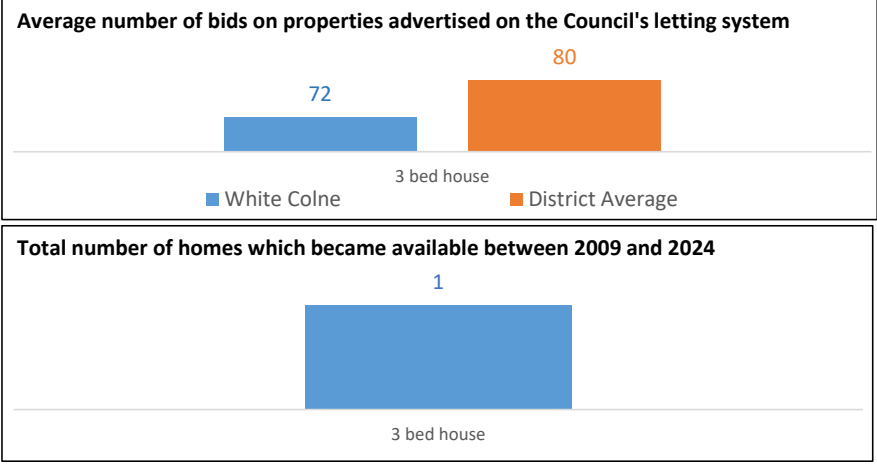

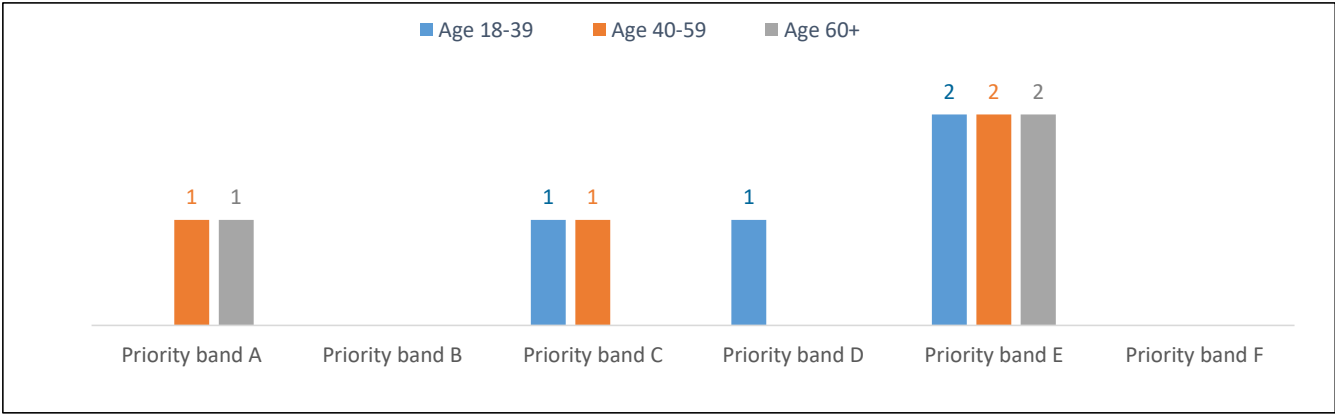
