The LPA produces a suite of Parish Key Housing Needs Statistics (Housing Stat Nav) which confirms the number of people on their register seeking affordable housing by type and need etc. Analyses of these documents appear to show disproportionate growth to the South of the District - leading to unmet need to the North.
