


Figure 1 Land between London Road and the A12 Study Area




Figure 2 Land between London Road and the A12 Listed Buildings




Figure 3 Land between London Road and the A12 EHER Point data (a single point could be an archaeological site, historic building, find spot or find spots)




Figure 4 Land between London Road and the A12 EHER Polygon data (areas defined as archaeological sites)




Figure 5 Land between London Road and the A12 NMP data (cropmarks recorded by aerial photography)




Figure 7 Land adjacent to the A12, Marks Tey: Study Area (flood plain shaded in blue)




Figure 8 Gateway 120: Listed Buildings




Figure 9 Gateway 120 and Land adjacent to the A12, Marks Tey: Scheduled Monuments (in blue)




Figure 10 Gateway 120 EHER Point data (a single point could be an archaeological site, historic building, find spot or find spots)




Figure 13 Gateway 120 EHER Roman data (Roman road line in black)




Figure 14 Gateway 120 EHER Medieval data




Figure 15 Gateway 120 and Land adjacent to the A12, Marks Tey: NMP data (cropmarks recorded by aerial photography)




Figure 16 Land adjacent to the A12, Marks Tey: Listed Buildings




Figure 17 Land adjacent to the A12, Marks Tey: EHER Point data (a single point could be an archaeological site, historic building, find spot or find spots)



Figure 18 Land adjacent to the A12, Marks Tey: EHER Polygon data




Figure 19 Land adjacent to the A12, Marks Tey: EHER Prehistoric data




Figure 20 Land adjacent to the A12, Marks Tey: EHER Roman data (Roman road lines in black)




Figure 21 Land adjacent to the A12, Marks Tey: EHER Medieval data




Figure 22 Land between London Road and the A12 Study Area with First Edition One Inch Ordnance Survey Map (1799)




Figure 23 Land adjacent to the A12, Marks Tey and Gateway 120 (north) with First Edition One Inch Ordnance Survey Map (1799)




Figure 24 Land adjacent to the A12, Marks Tey and Gateway 120 (south) with First Edition One Inch Ordnance Survey Map (1799)
