1 - Introduction and Background

Braintree District Council is currently working on reviewing its Local Plan. As part of this work it is necessary to assess the impact of the policies contained within it on equality. This report details the results of an Equality Impact Assessment (EqIA) of the Braintree District Local Plan Review which is proposed for consultation under Regulation 18. The main purpose of the EqIA is to assess whether the Local Plan has an impact on different groups of people in different ways. It looks at the likely impact on these groups and how the needs of such groups have been taken into account in relation to the development of the Local Plan and policies and proposals in it.

The Local Plan sets out the planning policies for 2026 to 2041. It sets out proposals for the development and growth, and policies to protect and enhance the natural and built environment of Braintree District. The Local Plan will replace the two part Local Plan which was a joint Plan with Colchester City Council and Tendring District Council which was adopted in 2021 and the Braintree specific section 2 Plan which was adopted in 2022. The Local Plan consists of;

- A spatial vision for the district with objectives and policies which will help guide development over the plan period to 2041 .
- Allocations which will help provide development to meet the identified needs of the district.
- Development Management policies which guide and help shape new development.

EqIA has been undertaken through out the Local Plan preparation process to help ensure that the impacts of the Plan on equalities are fully understood, with each report to Local Plan sub-committee having a high level assessment of the likely impacts the contents of that report may have.

Further EqIA assessment will be carried out at Regulation 19 Submission consultation.

There has been previous consultation at Issues and Options stage in 2025 and prior to that in 2024 and informal Ideas and Issues consultation in 2024 which sought general views on what a new Local Plan should contain, and which issues it should cover.

This Local Plan will be subject to examination in public following submission at the end of December 2026. Once adopted the impact of the policies will be monitored through the Council's Annual Monitoring Report.

Legal Context

Braintree District Council is required to have regard to the Public Sector Equality Duty at an early stage of policy formulation. An EqIA can help a Local Authority in making the necessary considerations and provides evidence of how a local authority has discharged the duty.

Under the Equalities Act 2010, the Council must comply with the Public Sector Equalities Duty to;

- Eliminate unlawful discrimination, harassment, and victimisation.
- Advance equality of opportunity between those who share a protected characteristic and those who do not; and
- Foster good relations between people who share a protected characteristic and those who do not.

The purpose of an EQIA

The EQIA is used to assess the potential impact of the policies in the new Local Plan on different groups within Braintree District. An assessment of the new Local Plan policies has been undertaken and will be kept under review as the Plan progresses. The following protected characteristics are included in the assessment (As defined by the Equalities Act 2010).

- Age: This refers to a person being a particular age or being within an age group. This includes all ages, including older people, children and young people.
- Sex: this is someone being either male or female.
- Disability: A person has a disability if he or she has a physical impairment which has a substantial and long term adverse impact on their ability to carry out normal day to day activities, for example physical, sensory, mental or learning impairment.
- Race: this includes colour, nationality (including citizenship), ethnic or national origins.
- Religion or belief: religion means any religion, including reference to a lack of religion. Belief includes religious and philosophical beliefs, any religious/faith or other groups with a recognised belief system or lack of belief.
- Sexual orientation: this is whether a person's sexual attraction is toward their own sex, or to both sexes
- Gender reassignment: this relates to people who are transitioning from one gender to another
- Pregnancy and maternity: this includes expectant others and mothers who have recently had a child. Protection against maternity discrimination is for 26 weeks after giving birth.

The Equality Act

There are three main aims of the Equalities Act which are set out in table 1 below. This table includes an explanation of how the new Local Plan policies relate to the aims of the equalities act.

2 - The Equality Impact Assessment

Stage 1 – Initial Screening

The purpose of the screening process is to see if the Local Plan presents any issues for any group of people. The screening process determines whether or not it is appropriate to carry out a full Equality Impact Assessment for this area of work. The main issue being considered is whether the Local Plan has the potential to cause any adverse impact or discrimination against different groups in the community.

It is considered that the scope of the Local Plan may have the potential for adverse impacts or discrimination against people with protected characteristics in view of its significance in terms of land use and development across the district over a long period of time. It is therefore considered necessary to carry out an EqIA of the Local Plan.

Stage 2 – Scoping and Defining

The EqIA has been prepared by officers in the Planning Policy Team who are responsible for the Local Plan preparation. Guidance has been sought from when necessary, from the Council's Governance team. Although the Equalities Act has nine protected characteristics it is not considered necessary to include an assessment against "marriage and civil partnership" as it is not relevant in the context of a Local Plan but rather for employment contexts.

Stage 3 – Information Gathering

To help the production of the EqIA officers have sourced various pieces of information to help determine whether the Local Plan is likely to have an adverse impact on, or discriminate against different groups within the community. This includes Census 2021 data and statistics produced by both Braintree District Council and Essex County Council.

Once the Local Plan completes Regulation 18 consultation, the comments received will be considered and any changes necessary made to the policies in the Plan. This will mean that if policies have been significantly changed, then they will be required to be assessed again for any impact, and a revised EqIA published.

Stage 4 – Making a judgement

Policies contained in the Local Plan aim to deliver the vision, objectives, and strategy set out within it.

The table below assess the impact of the policies contained within the Regulation 18 version of the Plan on the identified characteristics. The table is set out to show the policy number and its title, and where necessary any commentary on whether or not there are any potential policy impacts on the protected characteristics.

Section 4 of the report provides a summary of the likely impacts of the Local Plan as a whole.
