Memorandum of Understanding between Highways England and Essex County Council

1. Parties

Highways England

Essex County Council

2. Background

There are a number of existing and planned strategic highways schemes in or near Essex that are delivered by either Highways England or Essex County Council.

To coordinate these schemes and future ones, the Essex Strategic Highways Programme Group has been established (terms of reference attached in Appendix 1). This Memorandum of Understanding provides the formal agreement by both organisations to work collaboratively to deliver schemes with a coordinated approach to maximise the benefit and minimise disruption and costs.

3. Objectives

To create a Collaborative working environment between Highways England and Essex County Council providing a unified approach to the development of the road network in the County/region that maximises the benefits for both Parties and their customers and facilitates growth.

This will be coordinated through the Strategic Programme Group, a working group between Highways England and Essex County Council that implements this Memorandum of Understanding.

The Parties will work together to facilitate the delivery of each Parties strategic intent.

Where there is interface between proposed schemes, the parties commit to working together to create the best mutual outcome within the project parameters set out by each party.

The Parties will collaborate to sequence projects to maximise benefits and minimise disruption to the customers.

Where possible, the Parties commit to supporting each other's projects publically.





4. Values

Both Parties share similar values and within the Strategic Programme Group will work openly and collaboratively, building a trust between them to create solutions that deliver the needs of customers. Both Parties will provide clear leadership to their respective teams to help embed this collaborative relationship.
