

Almost double the District average of single and couple households over the age of 65

Over a third of people are 'economically inactive' (retired, carers and homemakers etc) 35% of people aged 16-74 are 'economically inactive', compared to the 26% District and 28% East of England figures







Applicants waiting for a housing association home to rent


