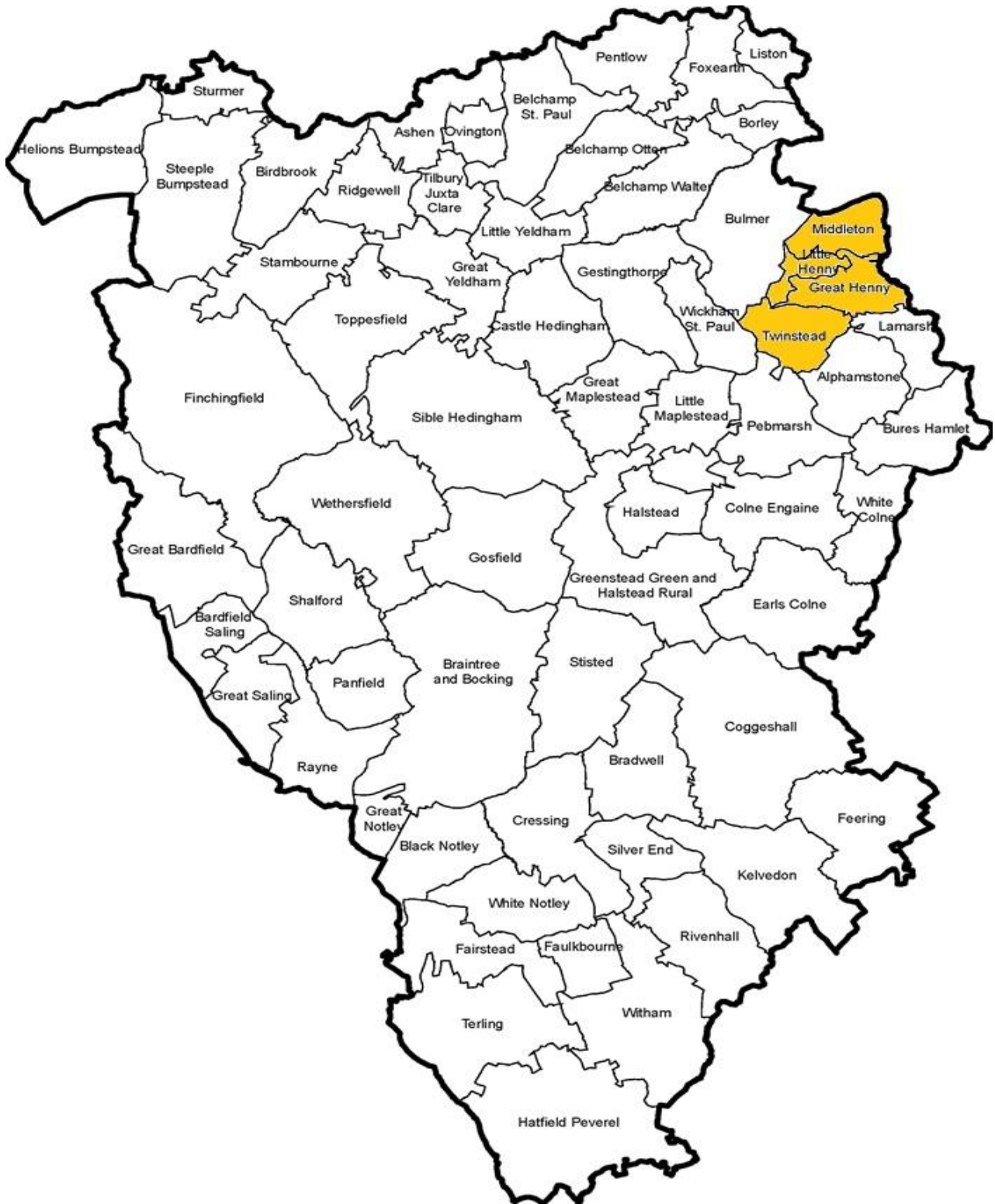

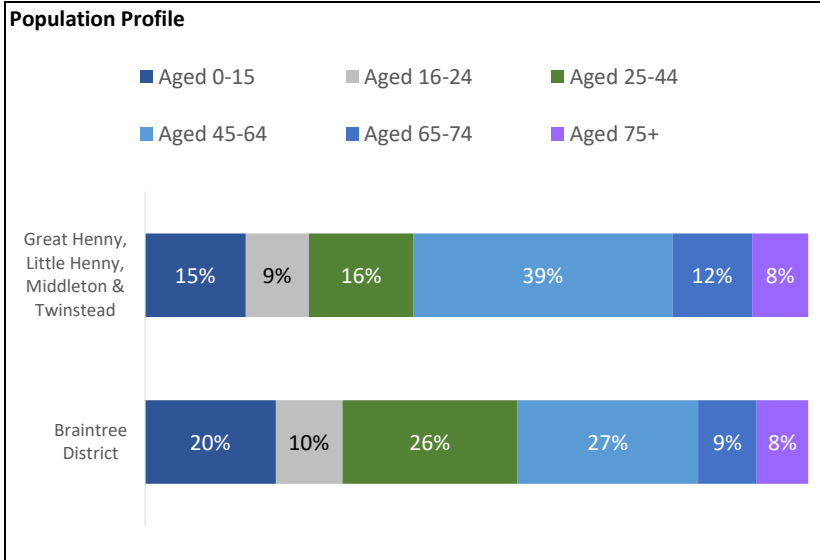

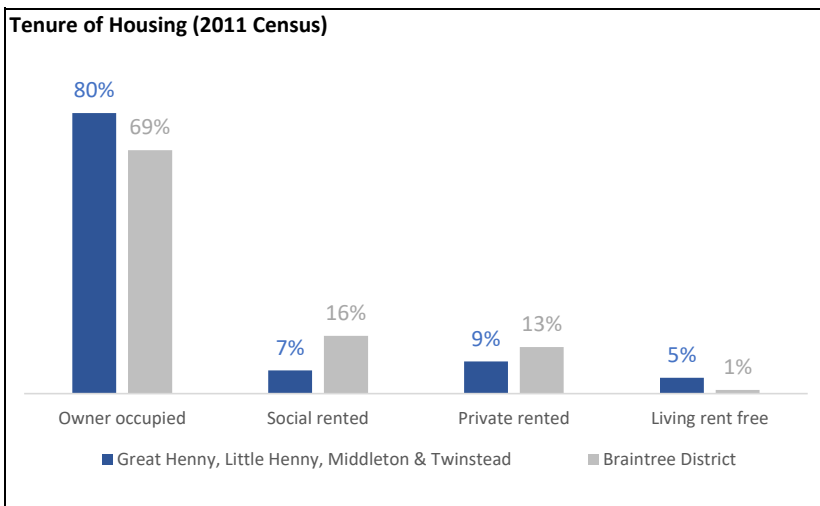
About the Parish of Great Henny, Little Henny, Middleton & Twinstead

- The population is 0.3% of the total Braintree District population (147,084)

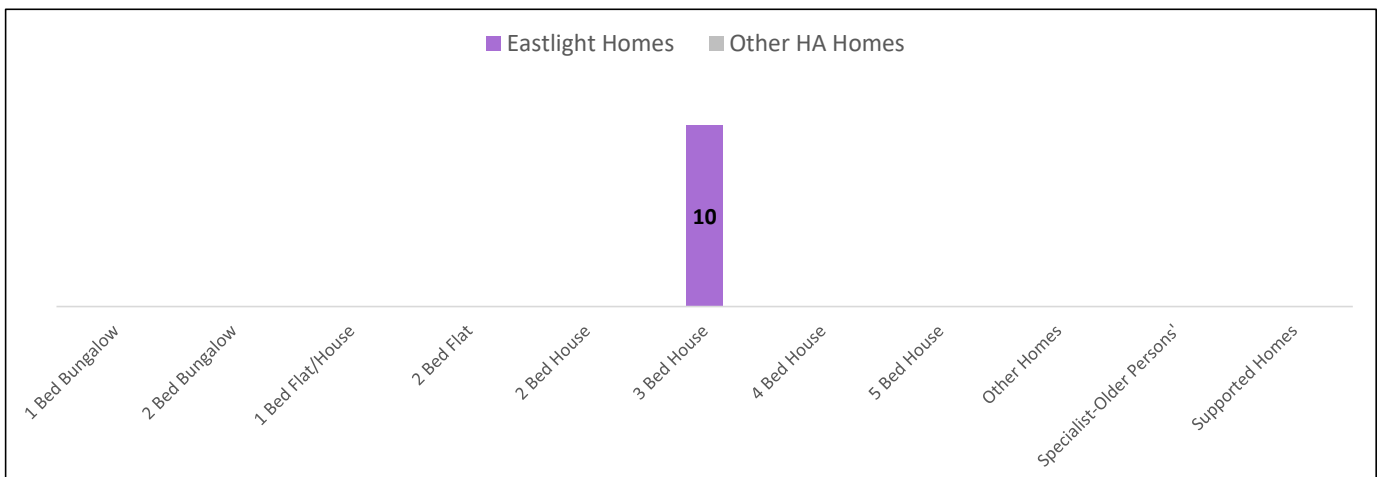
Over a quarter are couple households (under the age of 65) with no children
 At 28% of households, this is higher than the Braintree District proportion of 20%



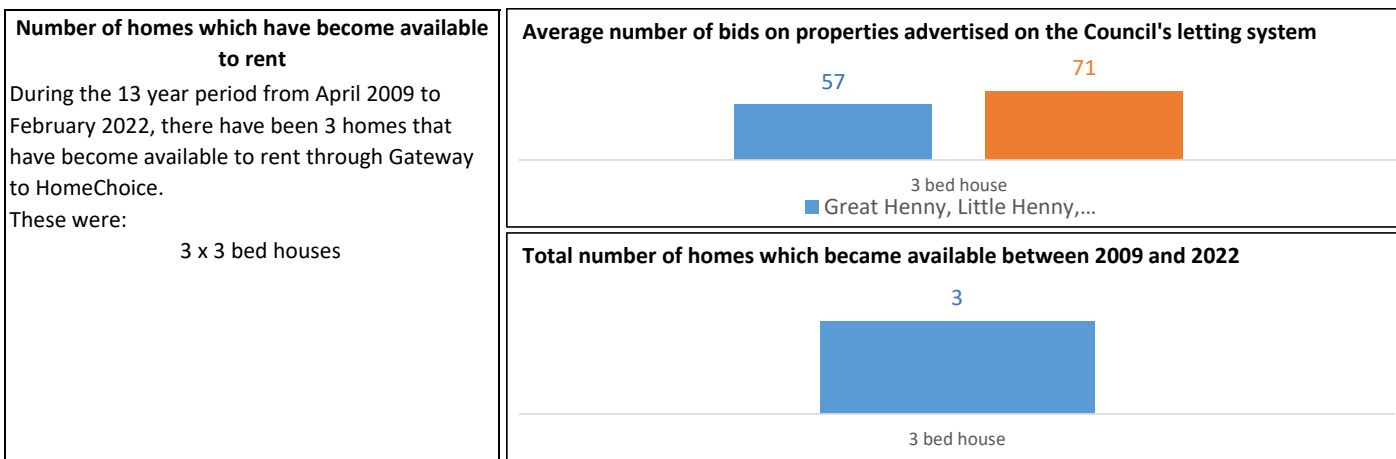
Lower proportion of single person households under the age of 65

Applicants waiting for a housing association home to rent

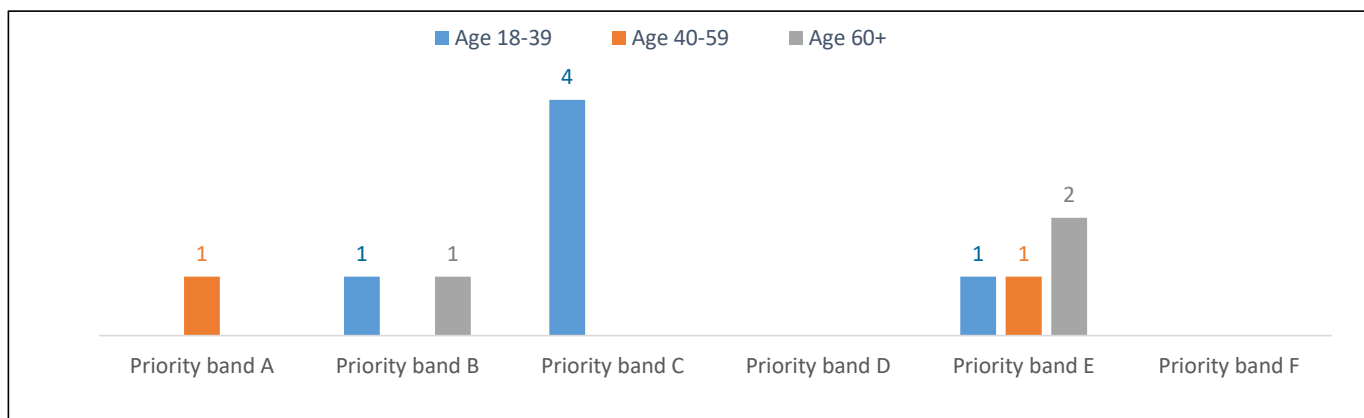
