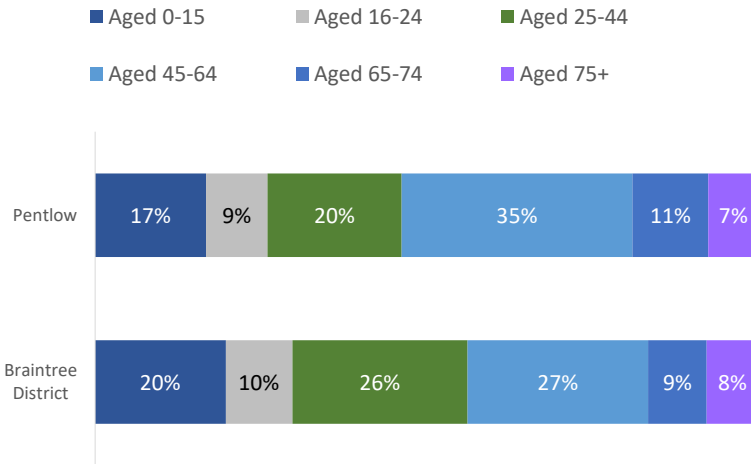

Higher proportion of couples with no children (under 65)

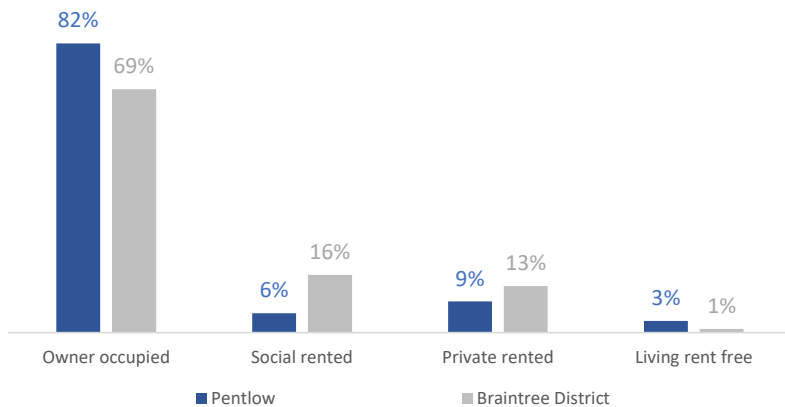
28% of households in the parish are couple households with no children, compared to the District and East of England averages of 20% and 19%



A third of people are not working due to being retired, carers or homemakers

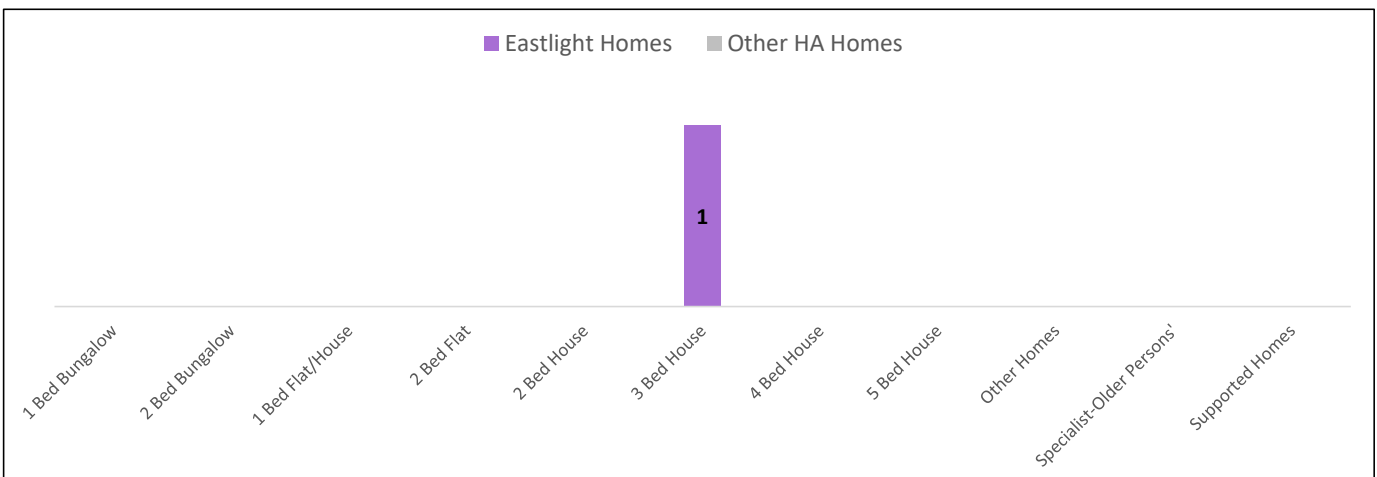
The proportion of 'economically inactive' residents is 32%, much higher than the District average of 26%

Tenure of Housing (2011 Census)

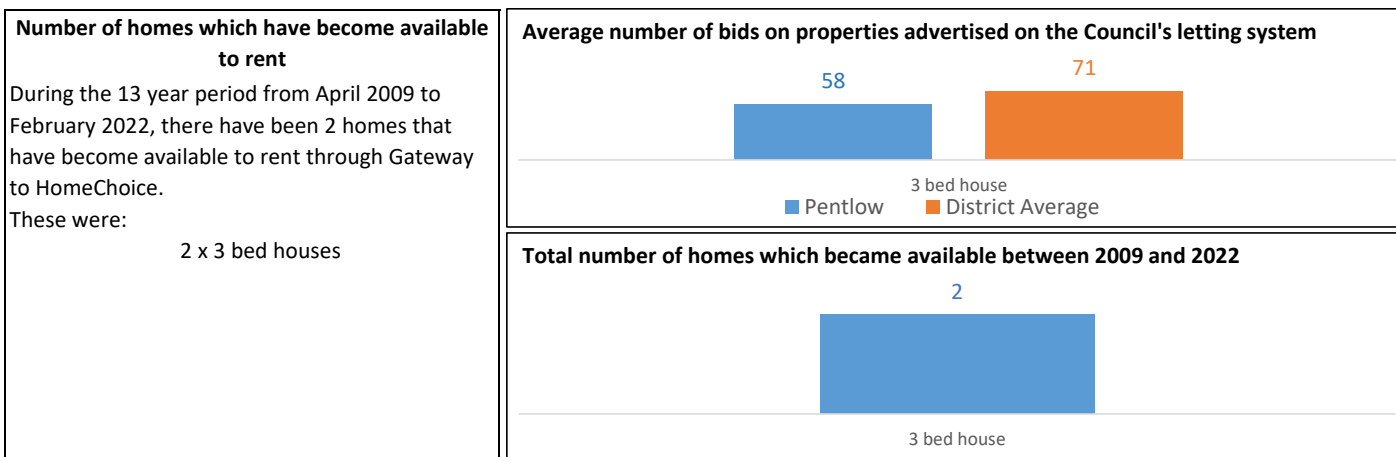

Applicants waiting for a housing association home to rent

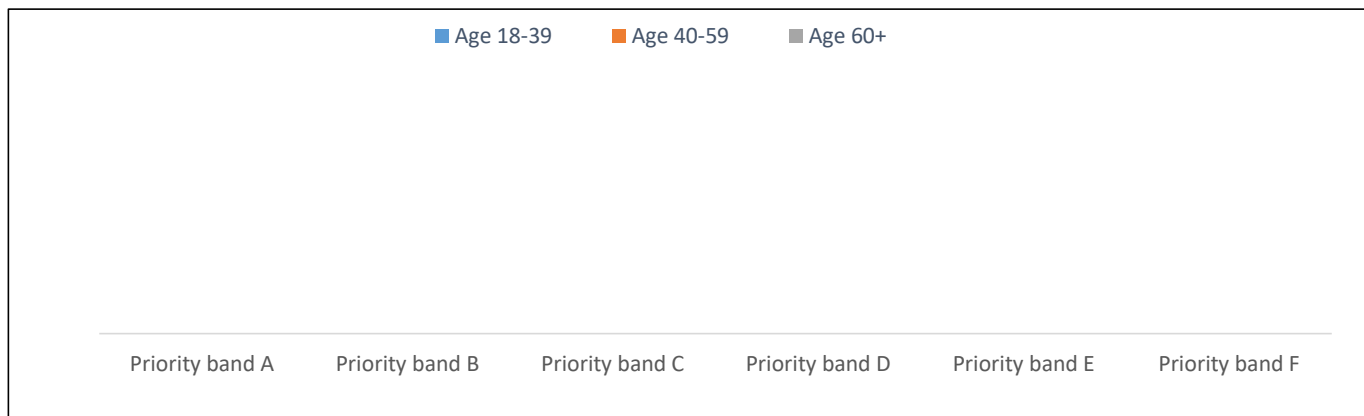
